### Course Description

This **two (2) day Inspiring Change: Using Motivational Interviewing to Support Engagement in Care** training is being offered twice on March 28th & 29th, and then again March 30th & 31st. For many clients living with HIV, staying in care or returning to care can be challenged by a complex set of experiences such as stigma, substance use, mental health, and cultural affiliations. In our responsibility as providers, it is important to examine barriers to care and support clients to achieve optimal health through engaging in care. This two day training will focus on the use of motivational interviewing techniques and related strategies to support and encourage engagement in care.

### Training Objectives

By the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Increase knowledge of the spirit and principles of motivational interviewing( MI).
- Build knowledge in recognizing and responding to change talk.
- Build skill in using the strategies and tools from MI to encourage change and resolve ambivalence related to HIV care.
- Develop recommendations and plan to support on-going learning and use MI.
